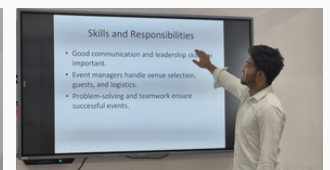
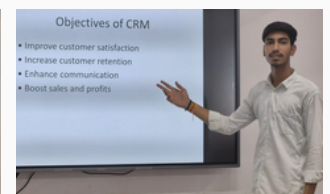
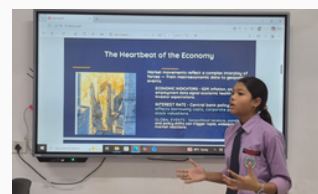
CAPSULE TRAINING PROGRAMME OVERVIEW – IIMAS

Employee Happiness Starts with Great HR Management



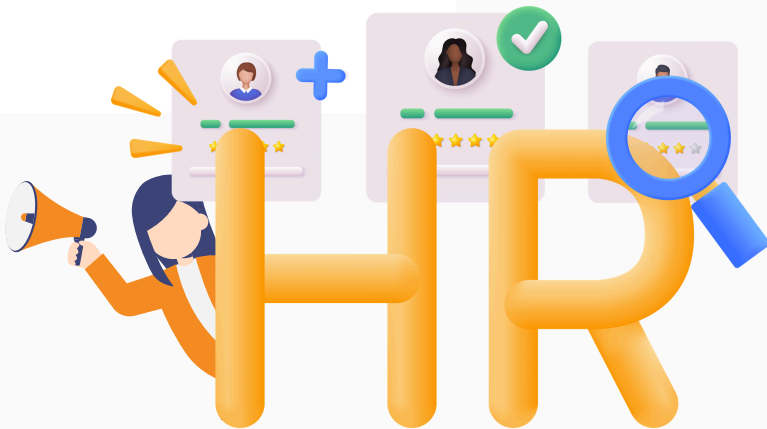
