
For this program total 100 students was registered and in lecture hall 70 students was presented.

The topic was covered in lecture as follow:-


- What is Drug interaction.
- Types of drug interaction.
- How to reduce risk of drug interaction.
- What is LASA drugs.
- How to arrange LASA dugs in medical store.

The lecture was started from what is drug interaction, drug interaction can be defined as the modification of the effect of one drug by the prior of another drug i.e. the effects are increased or decreased, or they produce a new effects that neither produces on its own. I explained different types of drug interaction as follow :-

- Drug- drug interaction – Drug drug interaction occurs when two or more drugs react with each other.
- Drug – food interaction –Drug food interaction result from drugs reacting with food or beverage.
- Environment induced interaction – These interaction are chiefly due to smoking that details both pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamic reaction.



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- Drug – disease interaction – Drug disease interaction may occur when an existing medical condition makes certain drug potentially harmful.

The net effect of a Drug Interaction is:

- Generally quantitative i.e. increased or decreased effect.
- Seldom qualitative i.e. rapid or slower effect.
- Precipitation of newer or increased adverse effect.

Drug interactions are mostly desirable and rarely desirable for eg enhancement of activity of penicillin when administered with probenecid. I was explained it which factors contributing to drug interaction as follow :-

1. Multiple drug therapy.
2. Multiple prescribers.
3. Multiple pharmacological effect of drug.
4. Multiple disease illness.
5. Poor patient compliance.


Drug interactions are usually considered in terms of three broad classes of underlying mechanism:

- Pharmacodynamic.
- Pharmacokinetic.
- Pharmaceutical incompatibility.


I explained about LASA drugs Look alike and sound alike drugs. LASA drugs involve medications that are visually similar in physical appearance or packaging and names of medication that have spelling similarities and similar phonetic.

Strategies to avoid errors with LASA –

- Prescription – Using both the brand, generic names, dosage form, dose and indication for use.
- Monitoring – Monitor new drugs added to the hospital formulary as they are released and provide guidelines to these new drugs.
- Information – Update healthcare professionals of changes on the list of LASA and confusing drug names.



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
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- Procurement – Minimise the availability of multiple medicines strengths, avoid similar packaging and appearance compare them with existing packaging.
- Storage – Use tall man lettering to emphasis.
- Dispensing – Identify medicines based on its name and strength and not by its appearance or location.
- Administration


The main reasons for improper dispensing of confusing drug names may due to lack of knowledge of registered pharmacist or due to less number of pharmacist during rush hours.
