

Value added course organized by (Index Institute of Pharmacy, from 13/05/2024 to 16/05/2024 for 4 hours per day; the speaker of this session was Dr. Javed Khan Pathan.

This programme was organized to enhance the knowledge and for the development of the

The topics are covered in her session are as follows:

- 1. Proper drug storage
- 2. Storage environment a)The storeroom
- 3. Schedule's of drug storage

b) The dispensary

On first day he took his session on the topic drug storage, the drugs stored in drug store be arranged in such a way that they are easily traceable as required according to the pharmacological action or according to alphabetical need.

Drugs are stored in specially designed secure area or space in order to avoid contamination, avoid disfiguration of table, maintain integrity of packaging and so guarantee quality and potency of drugs during shelf life, to prevent infestation of pest and vermin.

The storage should not hinder the cleaning and should have sufficient space for movement for stocks and handling.

Store the products as per product storage condition to prevent deterioration of finished product on storage. Monitor and record the temperature of the storage area on daily basis.

On second day he took his session on the topic storage environment. The storage environment should posses the following:

- Adequate temperature: 15-25°C is considered room temperature for pharmaceuticals industry.
- Sufficient lighting: exposure of light on drug, reduced potency of the drug because of photodecomposition. Adverse effects due to the formation of photo degradation products during storage.
- Humidity control: He makes us aware about the pharmaceutical storage areas, the humidity should be below 65%. Use dehumidifiers and air conditioners, especially in hot, humid climates, to reduce moisture in the air, but be sure that the appliances themselves don't become sources of biological pollutants.
- · Cold storage facilities: cold storage areas were an area restricted to certain environmental conditions to keep the products safe. Then he makes us aware about why cold temperature is necessary in pharmacy or what all drugs should be stored in cold condition. Cold temperature is to protect and control pharmaceutical products at the right temperature, from production to storage and then to the

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consumer. The drugs which are kept in cold storage are vaccine, glaucoma eye drops, insulin and aerosol spray age. insulin and aerosol spray against asthma. Storage condition of the dispensary: dispensary is a place where drugs or medicines were dispensed.

were dispensed.

In dispensary the drugs should be kept in a proper manner, drugs are arranged according to the albertal. according to the alphabetic order with proper label so that it will be easy to identify the drug.

The drugs which have same color should be mentioned on the top of the box, according to the pharmacological action.

Especially the LASA drugs should be kept separately because sometimes in hurry the chemist get confised to chemist get confused to dispensed the drug to the patient which will lead to

The drugs which has to be kept in cold temperature must be store at refrigerator, and must advised to the patient to follow the same procedure.

Then he took his session on the topic Schedule's of drug storage.

He discussed on the schedules of the drug storage:

Schedule 8 (S8) medicines (drugs of addiction) requiring refrigeration may be stored in a refrigerator.


At the end of the session participated members asked the queries.


