The course is free for all students. Interested students are requested to register for the course by 15 JUNE 2024 .

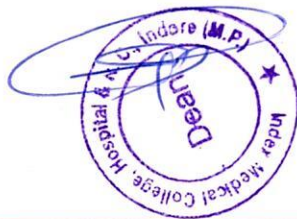

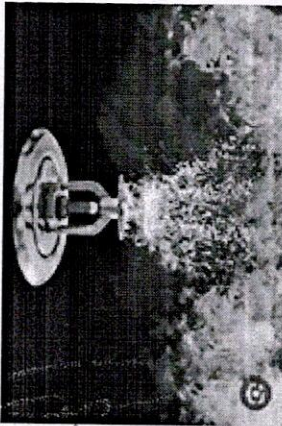

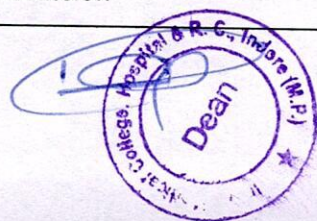

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Report: 'FIRE PREVENTION ,PROTECTION& MANGEMENT

A value added course on 'FIRE PREVENTION ,PROTECTION& MANGEMENT' was conducted on 24 JUNE to 26 JUNE, 2024, in LT-1 of Index Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Indore. This course was conducted for 18 hours, where each session was conducted for 6 hours. The total number of participants attending the course was 80.

The course was conducted for Final year medical students to learn and prepare themselves to effectively collaborate with colleagues with different experience levels or opinions and get to learn about fire protection and its prevention on the daily lives of individuals, and various ways to cope up with it.

The speakers of the course were Dr. Gourav Saxena, Associate Professor, Department of Surgery, Dr. Swati Saxena, Assistant Professor, Department of Ophthalmology & Dr. Amruta Loya, Assistant Professor, Department of Paediatrics

The course was conducted for three sessions; each session was conducted for 6 hours.

The modules for this course were as follow:

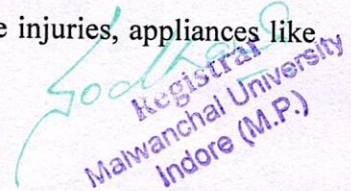
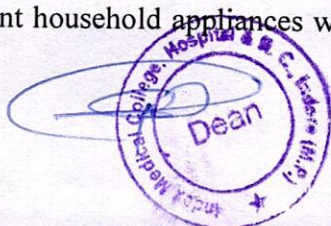
- What is Fire Protection?
- Prevention from fire disasters in daily life.
- Effective management of fire and other related disasters.

Fire protection and prevention is very important in everyday situations. It is an emergency to be dealt with immediate actions and is very stressful condition.

Thus, it becomes important for individuals to learn and know about fire protection and prevention to avoid unwanted consequences.

The various types of burn injuries were also discussed, like thermal burns, chemical burns, frost bite, electric burns and how to prevent these disasters.

It was explained that what should be done in daily routine life for protection against fire, what are the different household appliances which can cause devastating fire injuries, appliances like



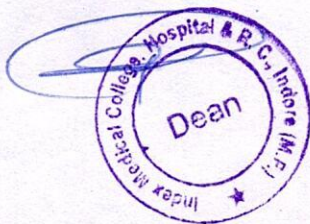
gas cylinders, electric circuits, lighters, matchsticks, cigarettes, acids, toilet cleaners, crackers etc. Apart from protection and prevention what immediate measures which should be taken if exposure occurs were also discussed in brief. There are no fire safety devices like fire extinguishers cylinders, balls available in maximum houses. Therefore, it is important for a medical professional to aware all people for fire protection and prevention.

How the adults in the home communicates with their children about fire protection and prevention will play an important role in avoiding accidents for example call for immediate help if there is any sparking due to short circuit, spillage of hot boiling water or milk etc.

Electric burns were also covered in details like turning off the power supply before approaching the victim, stop if you feel any tingling sensation in your legs, do not attempt to move any wires in hurry, do not flush with water.

At the end of this course, the participants learned about:

- Fire protection and its importance
- Types of fire injuries
- Manifestations of fire disasters.
- Prevention from fire injuries.
- Immediate emergency measures
- How to help a person suffering from Fire injuries at the site of accident.
- Educate children about fire safety and its consequences.

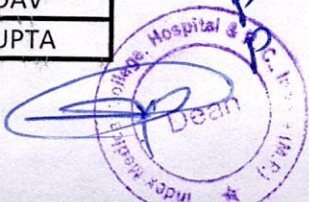


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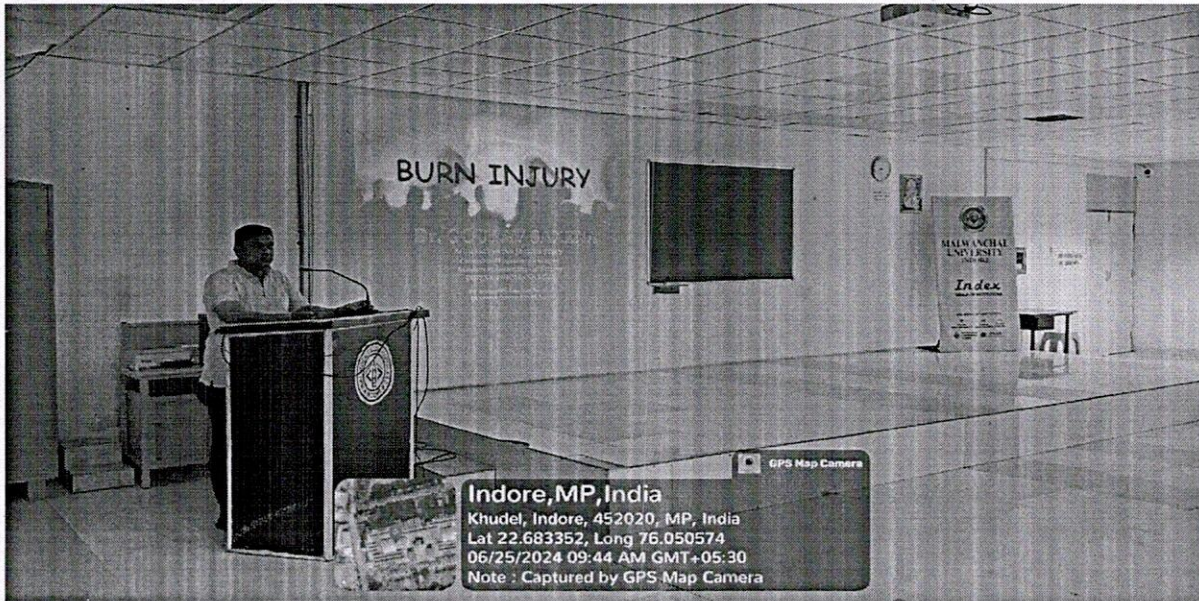
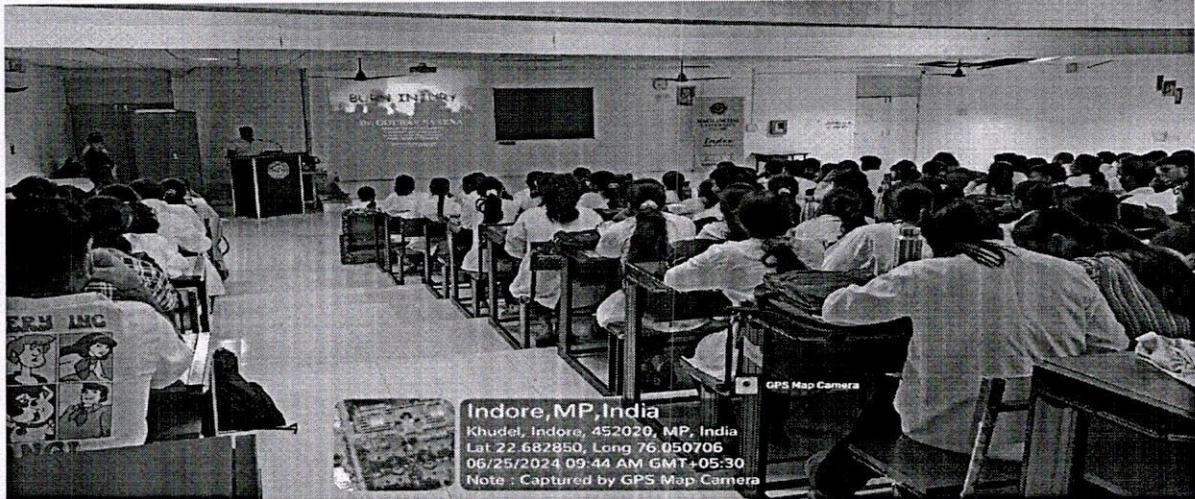
