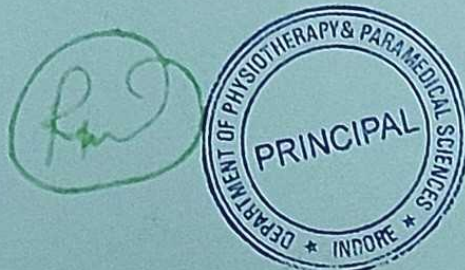

Outcomes:


1. Students gained a clear understanding of the code of conduct and code of ethics of physiotherapy.

Recommendations:


1. Conduct regular workshops and seminars to reinforce the code of conduct and code of ethics of physiotherapy.

3. Encourage students to participate in departmental activities and events, fostering a sense of community and teamwork.



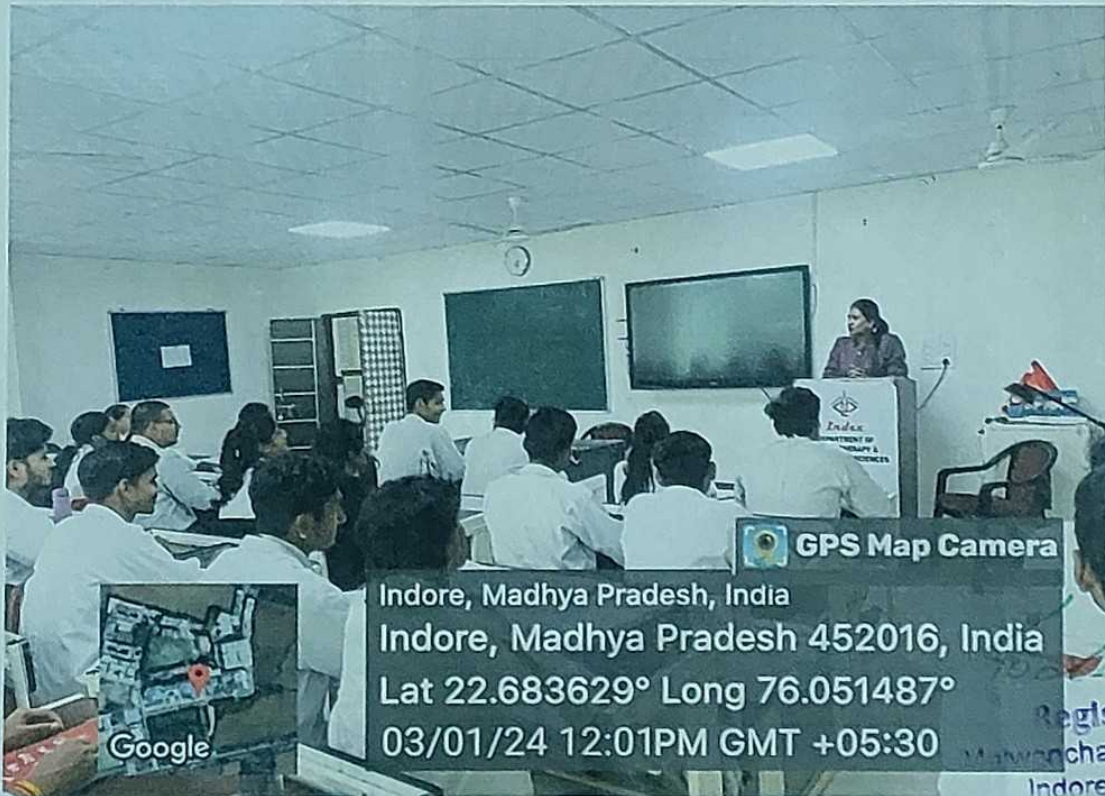
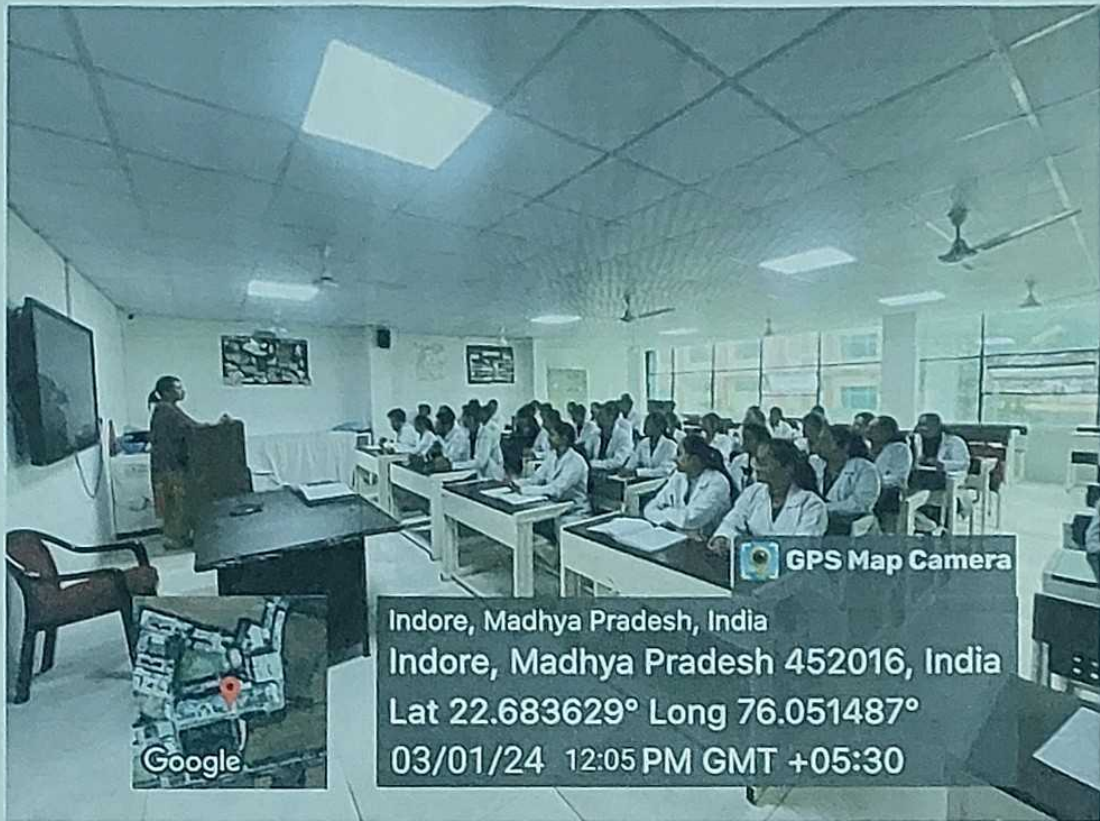
