



Oral Cancer Management Report

Introduction and Overview

Oral cancer is a significant public health concern, accounting for approximately 300,000 new cases worldwide annually. Physiotherapy plays a crucial role in the management of oral cancer, focusing on improving functional outcomes, reducing morbidity, and enhancing quality of life. As physiotherapy students, understanding the physiotherapeutic approach to oral cancer management is essential to provide comprehensive care to patients. This two-day report summarizes the key takeaways from the oral cancer management workshop attended by physiotherapy students, highlighting the importance of physiotherapy interventions in oral cancer care.

Oral cancer management involves a multidisciplinary approach, requiring collaboration between healthcare professionals. Physiotherapists contribute to the management of oral cancer by addressing:

- Dysphagia (swallowing disorders)
- Dysarthria (speech difficulties)
- Trismus (limited mouth opening)
- Neck and shoulder pain
- Lymphedema (swelling)

Day 1: Assessment and Early Intervention

The first day of the workshop focused on assessment and early intervention strategies for oral cancer patients. Key concepts discussed included:

- Clinical evaluation of oral cancer patients
- Assessment tools for dysphagia, dysarthria, and trismus


