

- 2. Structure of human right
- 3. Justification of human right
- 4. 6 basic human right

On first day He took her session on the topic introduction rights every person has dignity and value. What do Rights mean? Rights are those claims and demands of an individual or group of individuals to good life which are accepted by the community or society. Human rights are a set of principles concerned with equality and fairness. Human rights can broadly be defined as a number of basic rights that people from around the world have agreed are essential. These include the right to life, the right to a fair trial, freedom from torture and other cruel and inhuman treatment, freedom of speech, freedom of religion, and the rights to health, education and an adequate standard of living. He also makes us aware about the responsibilities to protect human rights. Individuals have a responsibility to ensure that they exercise their rights with consideration for the rights of others. For example, when someone uses their right to freedom of speech, they should do so without interfering with someone else's right to speech.

On second day He took his session on the topic structure of human right. They include civil, political, economic, social and cultural rights. She explained each and every topic in detailed

• Civil rights: civil rights, guarantees of equal social opportunities and equal protection under the law, regardless of race, religion, or other personal characteristics. Civil rights are an essential component of democracy; when individuals are being denied opportunities to participate in political society, they are being denied their civil rights.

• Political rights: They include such rights as the right to vote and elect representatives, the right to contest elections, the right to form political parties or join them. In this every individual has the right to vote of their choice, to join the political parties or can be a contestant of election.

- Economic Rights: Economic rights protected by the ICESCR include the rights to work, to receive a fair wage, safe working conditions, and to form and join trade unions.
- Social rights: Social rights are the rights of people to achieve their basic human needs.
- Cultural rights: Cultural rights are human rights that aim at assuring the enjoyment of culture and its components in conditions of equality, human dignity and non-discrimination. India is a country where it has numbers of different cultures. And every individual has the right to enjoy their culture.

On third day He took her session on the topic Justification of human right in this He explained about that, the Human rights are first and foremost weapons in combating certain evils that human beings inflict upon one another, they emphasize standards of treatment that no human being could justifiably deny to others. Human rights have a common ground in one basic moral right, the right to justification.

And after that He explained all the 6 basic human right: They are Right to Equality, Right to Freedom, Right against Exploitation, Right to Freedom of Religion, Cultural and Educational Rights, and Right to Constitutional Remedies. He explained all the rights in short.

Right to Equality: in this he explained that every individual has the equal rights. Men and women should have equal rights.

Right to Freedom: It includes freedom of speech and expression, assembly, association or union or cooperatives, movement, and residence. It also includes the right to practice any profession or occupation.

Right against Exploitation: The Right against exploitation prohibits all types of forced labour, child labour. Not a single person is forced or pressurized to work for anyone.

Right to Freedom of Religion: India is a country where there is different religion like Hindu, Muslim, Sikh, Jain, Buddhism and Christianity. Every individual has a right to follow any religion according to his/her choice. No one is compelled or to forced any religion.




