Doctor's Day Celebration and Oral Health Awareness Program Inspires Young Minds



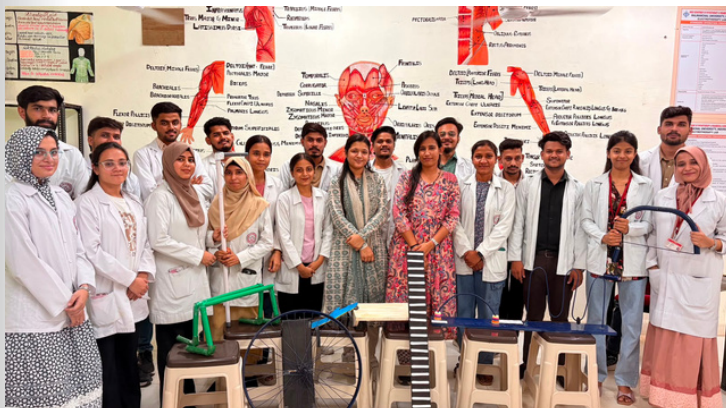
